*A major aspect of the Human Rights project was the involvement of a township school near Johannesburg, the Ithuba Skills College. The students themselves not only acted out of human rights abuses, serving as the protagonists of each story, their enthusiasm and their environment inspired and motivated the project from April 2009 to March 2010.*

*We intent to reach far beyond the capacity of the written word, exploiting the highly emotive and dramatic medium of staged photography.*
